The Hurley Group

The Hurley Group is a leading primary care provider in London. We run 17 practices across the capital, as well as four Walk in Centres and four Urgent Care Centres. We are specialists in inner city general practice, and many of our sites are in areas with high substance misuse and mental health burden.

We also run the Practitioner Health Programme; an independent service looking after the health of 27,000 doctors and dentists across London; this free confidential service deals with clinicians who have mental or physical health concerns and/or addiction problems.

GP First Scheme

The Scheme

We are seeking to recruit enthusiastic GPs within their first three years of qualification to join the Hurley Group team. Employment to be on a salaried basis with flexible working opportunities and portfolio development prospects.

We are offering successful candidates competitive salary for 8 Clinical sessions and 1 paid CPD (continuing professional development) session per week. 6 weeks annual leave, 1 week study leave. Additional scheme opportunities including

- Potential for a flexible working week
- A mentor from within the Hurley Group leadership team (clinical or managerial)
- Facilitated monthly peer-support meetings (young practitioner group)
- Access to our "all doctors" email where you can email clinical questions to all of our 60 GPs for an immediate live answer mid-consultation
- Access to protected training budget
- Participation in innovative projects in areas of interest including non-clinical aspects: managerial, IT, communications, finance, new bids
- Shadowing in specialised clinics within the hospital setting or with local GPwSIs
- Access to the staff intranet including all policies and guidelines and the online clinical support network
- Hurley Group social and networking events

Flexible working

You will get the opportunity to work across our sites, which include both large and smaller GP practices, training practices, GP Walk in Centres and Urgent Care Centres.

The rota is flexible and allows you to vary your working pattern to suit or to work regular fixed days if you prefer. You can book sessions online weeks or even months in advance. In 2013/14 our GP First doctors fixed 4 sessions/week and rotated for 4 sessions, which provided a good balance.

Beyond GP First

We aspire to nurture and support the talents of future GPs with a view to career progression both within the Hurley Group and beyond our organisation. GP First will be the stepping-stone for recently qualified GPs searching for a supportive and integrated clinical environment, where career progression and leadership development is actively fostered.

Beyond the scheme GPs may have various options open to them:

- Grow with us, as we continue to grow. Several years ago our team was 25 people strong. We are now over 250 and have acquired a new practice every quarter for the last 4 years
- Explore opportunities for career development within the Hurley Group as a Lead GP – we now have 22 Lead GPs working with us across the Group
- We also encourage you developing your own portfolio career within the Group
- Be supported in applications to pursue roles outside of the Hurley Group
